The Catholic Office for Youth and Young Adults (COYYA) in the Archdiocese of Adelaide were excited to announce the 2019 World Youth Day local festival in Adelaide, South Australia to correspond with the international #WYD celebrations taking place in Panama. Young people aged 16 to 35 were invited to Sacred Heart College senior campus in Adelaide's beautiful Somerton Park for a celebration which will include live music on three stages, speakers and workshops, food trucks, amusements, and a dynamic liturgy led by young people.

WYD international media coordinator Jamie Lynn Black, said that "World Youth Days have typically been held in July, and while that is convenient for Europeans and pilgrims from the US, most young Central Americans are in school then. This time around, they have been given an opportunity to host an event during their summer," she said. This also works well in Australia, with corresponding WYD 2019 celebrations being held prior to the start of the school year.

## Feast Days of the week

#### Mon Jan 28 St Thomas Aquinas (1224-1274)

Doctor of the Church, Dominican priest and one of the greatest theologians of the Church, Thomas Aquinas is known as the 'Angelic Doctor', author of the *Summa Theologica*. Born of a noble family in Aquino, a town in southern Italy from which he takes his surname. In the year before his death, he had a mystical experience in the light of which he felt that everything he had written seemed worthless.

#### Thu Jan 31 St John Bosco (1815-1888)

Don Bosco was born of poor parents in Piedmont, Italy. Founder of the Salesian Society (named after St Francis de Sales), and devoted to teaching the young especially the poor, Don Bosco believed education to be a 'matter of the heart', and said that the children must not only be loved, but know that they are loved. When declared a saint in 1934, he was given the title of 'Father and Teacher of Youth'.

#### Sat Feb 2 Presentation of the Lord

In accordance with the Jewish Law – the story is told in Luke's Gospel, Ch.2 - Jesus was presented in the Temple by his mother, Mary, and his foster father, Joseph. This is another 'epiphany', a revealing of the Christ Child as the Messiah through the words of Simeon, and the testimony of Anna, the prophetess. Simeon was a man on whom 'the Holy Spirit rested' and was 'prompted by the Spirit' to come to the Temple that day. Christ is the light of the nations, hence the blessing and procession of candles on this say of himself: "I live now not with my own life but with the life of Christ who lives in me." (Gal 2:20)
