Feast Days of the Week

Mon Jun 10 The Blessed Virgin Mary, Mother of the Church


The Solemnity of Mary, the Holy Mother of God is a feast day of the Blessed Virgin Mary under the aspect of her motherhood of Jesus Christ, whom Christians see as the Lord, Son of God.

Tue Jun 11 St Barnabas, apostle

We meet St Barnabas in Acts 4:36-37: 'There was a Levite of Cypriot origin called Joseph whom the apostles surnamed Barnabas.' He was probably converted shortly after Pentecost and while not one of the Twelve, he is regarded like St Paul as an 'apostle'. When the disciples were slow to accept the former persecutor, Saul of Tarsus, 'Barnabas took charge of him, introduced him to the apostles and explained how the Lord had appeared to him.' (Acts 9:27) Founder of the church in Antioch, Barnabas accompanied first Paul and then Mark on taking the Gospel to the Gentiles.

Thu Jun 13 St Anthony of Padua, 1195 – 1231

One of the most loved saints, Anthony was born in Lisbon, Portugal, to a wealthy family and was named Ferdinand Martins de Bulhões. First a member of the Augustinian Order, he joined the Franciscans when he was 26 years old. A gifted preacher in both Italy and France, he was called the 'hammer of the heretics'. When heretics would not listen to him, he went out and preached to the fish, not for the instruction of the fish, but rather for the glory of God, the delight of the angels, and the easing of his own heart. He died in Padua, Italy, at the age of 36 and was declared a Doctor of the Church by Pope Pius XII in 1946.


