

#### Feast Days of the Week

#### Mon Oct 28 Sts Simon and Jude, Apostles

The name of Simon occurs in all the passages of the Gospel and Acts where a list of the Apostles is given. To distinguish him from St Peter he is called the Zealot meaning that he had zeal for the Jewish Law which he practised before his call. Jude, known as Thaddaeus, was a brother of James, son of Alphaeus. Jude was the one who asked Jesus at the Last Supper why he would not manifest Himself to the whole world after His resurrection. He is the author of a short letter which forms part of the New Testament. Tradition has it that Simon and Jude preached in Persia where they were martyred.


