#### **VINNIES BUSHFIRE RELIEF UPDATE**

In South Australia, generous donors have raised more than \$1.3 million and we are very grateful for this response.

We have been working closely with the SA Government State Recovery Office to assist with material donations as requested, and to act as a link between donors of products and services and those who require this type of assistance.

Vinnies SA has been given access to the SA Government Bushfire Recovery Centre in Lobethal in order to meet with those affected, and to begin processing applications for financial support. We are also involved in the recovery effort on Kangaroo Island. To date we have received approximately 60 applications for financial assistance (from the Yorketown, Cudlee Creek and Kangaroo Island regions), and the first payments commenced 27 January 2020.

As we anticipate the receipt of many more applications for assistance, the distribution of funds will occur in multiple rounds to ensure it occurs equitably, and so that people who have been unable to apply in the first instance will not be disadvantaged.

Along with the distribution of funds raised via the Vinnies SA Bushfire Appeal, we have been contracted by the Federal Government to distribute Emergency Relief Funding to households living or working in the fire-affected regions, who are suffering financial hardship as a result of the fires. Funding to eligible applicants will also commence next week.

Vinnies is committed to ensuring that 100% of donations go directly to bushfire victims and we are working tirelessly to get funds to those who need it most.

# Key points:

- 1. 100% of donations to the Vinnies Bushfire Appeal are being used to support people affected by the fires.
- 2. We are not taking any administration fees for this emergency appeal, and donations will not be used to pay internal costs.
- 3. We are not saving appeal funds for future disasters donations will be spent to provide relief and recovery from the current bushfires.



#### REFLECTING ON GOD'S PROMISES

Today's Gospel reminds us that we wait for something more. Like Simeon and Anna, we long to see the fullness of the reign of God here on earth. We ache for

the peace that God alone can bring. We yearn for the Light that will vanish all darkness. We wait, trusting God's promise to be with us always. Will we try to live as Christ now, we wait for the day when we will live in the joy of the Resurrection, because the Kingdom is both here and not yet. We wait for the day when we, like Simeon and Anna, will know the salvation of God that has been promised Simeon's words in today's Gospel, known as the Canticle of Simeon, are typically prayed at the end of each day. This evening, pray Simeon's words before you go to sleep. Ask God to let you sleep in peace, knowing God's promise to be with you. Rest confident and assured that Christ is the light that destroys all darkness.

# Feast Days of the Week: Wednesday Feb 5 St Agatha

We know little about this third century saint other than that she has been honoured since ancient times and her name is included in the Canon of the Mass. Young, beautiful and rich, Agatha lived a life consecrated to God and because of her refusal to deviate from that path, she suffered death as a martyr.

# Thursday Feb 6 St Paul Miki (1562-1597) and Companions, Martyrs

Paul Miki, the son of a Japanese military leader, joined the Jesuit Order in 1580, and became known for his eloquent preaching. Crucified in 1597 with 25 companions, Paul's words from the cross were: 'The only reason for my being killed is that I have taught the doctrine of Christ. I thank God it is for this reason that I die. I believe that I am telling the truth before I die. I know you believe me and I want to say to you all once again: Ask Christ to help you become happy. I obey Christ. After Christ's example, I forgive my persecutors. I do not hate them. I ask God to have pity on all, and I hope my blood will fall on my fellow men as a fruitful rain.'
