#### **Feast Days of the Week** Tue Jan 28 St Thomas Aquinas (1224-1274)

Doctor of the Church, Dominican priest and one of the greatest theologians of the Church, Thomas Aquinas is known as the 'Angelic Doctor', author of the Summa Theologica. Born of a noble family in Aquino, a town in southern Italy from which he takes his surname. In the year before his death, he had a mystical experience in the light of which he felt that everything he had written seemed worthless.

#### Fri Jan 31 St John Bosco (1815-1888)

Don Bosco was born of poor parents in Piedmont, Italy. Founder of the Salesian Society (named after St Francis de Sales), and devoted to teaching the young especially the poor, Don Bosco believed education to be a 'matter of the heart', and said that the children must not only be loved, but know that they are loved. When declared a saint in 1934, he was given the title of 'Father and Teacher of Youth'.
